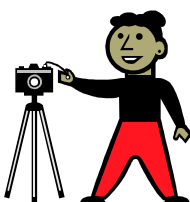


### Allotment Digging

If anyone can spare some time we still have a little bit of digging to do. Please speak to the office staff.

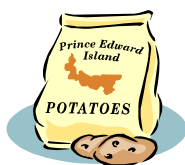
### Class Photos Wednesday 12th May
