

Dear Parents/Carers,

This week has been very exciting in EYFS - the children are bringing home their first reading books!

Our first level of reading books are pictures only and we encourage children to tell their own stories.

We will be beginning our phonics sessions next week and we will learn a new sound (phoneme) each day. As the children are ready, we will be sending these sounds home for them to practise these with you with their reading robot.

Books will be changed weekly by classroom staff but we do ask that books are brought in every day.

The children will also have opportunities to take home books from our school library, these will be books to share with a grown up at home. Library books will also be changed weekly.

We ask that children read at least five times a week to an adult at home and this can be a school book or a book from home. Please could you record any books shared in the reading record book.
