

PE and Sport Premium for Primary Schools 2017

Each year the school receives money from the government to pay for all of the resources we need to run the school and educate the children. One aspect of this funding is our School Sports Funding.

We are held accountable for how we have used the additional funding to support pupils. The funding will be used to;

- Increase the number of pupils who participate in games, dance, gymnastics, athletics and other physical activity
- Increase our involvement in competitive school sports
- Ensure that our physical education curriculum is inclusive and enables everyone to participate
- Increase the range of sporting activities that are available to the children
- Improve the ways in which we work in partnership with other schools and local partners to deliver physical education
- Ensure that there are clear links with other curriculum subjects and that PE contributes to the overall achievement of the children. This includes their Social, Spiritual, Moral and Cultural skills
- Support children and their families to understand the dangers of obesity, smoking and other activities that can damage children's health.

For the current academic year we have been using our Sports Funding for two main purposes.

1. Mrs Ros Marsh will be temporarily employed as a Sports Teacher for one day a week to lead provision across the school. Mrs Marsh will be working on a range of activities to support all of the areas listed above. The aim of Mrs Marsh's work will be to build capacity within school so that high levels of Sports Provision can be maintained once the funding ceases. Mrs Marsh is our Primary Link Teacher with The School Sports Partnership and is involved in a range of initiatives and training. She will be working with other staff at Hilltop Infant School to introduce new training and to increase the number of sporting activities that we offer. Mrs Marsh will still be linking with The School Sports Partnership and increasing the number of opportunities for children to engage in sporting activities with other schools.
2. We are buying into The School Sports Partnership. Mrs Marsh and other staff will continue to receive training from specialist staff in areas such as Gymnastics teaching. The School Sports Co-ordinators from The Partnership will be arranging inter-school events such as the skipping festival, Teddy Bears Picnic and a Mini-Olympics.
